A collared golf shirt and golf related layering piece is our preferred choice. Our female members and guests are allowed to wear sleeveless golf shirts designed for the golf course. Female golfers must wear a top and bottom that doesn't reveal too much. Again, we want our dress code to be relaxed but not to the point that others find it distracting, disturbing or inappropriate. Golf Shoes or golf sandals with soft spikes or athletic shoes must be worn at all times while playing. Members and guests are not allowed to play barefooted or with footwear that could damage the grass plant. It is every member's responsibility to make sure their guests are aware of our dress code policy on the golf course.

Clubhouse Dress Code
